## ENTRY CANCELLATIONS:

- All entry cancellations after the closing date must be made in writing to [entries@wesleycloverparks.com](mailto:entries@wesleycloverparks.com).
- Entries cancelled in writing at least 24 hours prior to the first class of the show will be charged the administration fee.
- Cancelled entries that do not provide at least 24 hours notice will be charged a \$30 cancellation fee and the administration fee, class/division fees will be waived.
- Stalls are non-refundable after the closing date.
- Management reserves the right to assess any cancellations on a case-by-case basis.

## STABLING

**Stabling Request Closing Date: Monday, July 5, 2021 at 11:59PM. No refunds after this date.**

Stabling Requests are made through “*Service Orders*” in your exhibitor account at [www.MyESM.ca](http://www.MyESM.ca). There will be limited stabling available due to Covid-19 guidelines. Please submit stall orders first if you require stalls. You can increase your stall orders anytime through your “*Service Orders*” in MyESM. Decreases can only be done until the closing date.

**Arrivals:** Friday, July 9 from 10:00AM to 6PM

**Departures:** Sunday, July 11 by end of day

**Site closed daily from 11:00PM until 5:00AM** except in the case of emergency. All entrants to the site must stop at reception agent at all times.

No hay or shavings orders will be accepted after noon on Saturday. All requests must be made through your MyESM account under “*Service Orders*”. Any requests sent via text message or email will not be filled. Splits for any services between horses you have entered in the show, under your exhibitor account must be done by Saturday at noon.

## MEMBERSHIP RULES

- All riders and owners must have a current provincial membership (OE or equivalent) and minimum Bronze EC sport license to compete in the Bronze competition. All riders and owners must have current provincial membership (OE or equivalent), and minimum Silver EC sport license to compete in the Silver competition.
- If rider or owner of the horse/pony do not have an EC Sport License you will be required to purchase a bronze license kit at the show. Your points will not count for this show with a temporary EC Sport License.
- Adult Amateur riders must have Amateur Status on their Equestrian Canada membership card. These will be checked.
- THJA membership, for both owner and rider, is required to accrue points for Trillium Championships and year end awards.

## EQUINE HEALTH REQUIREMENTS & BIOSECURITY

Wesley Clover Parks endeavours to provide a healthy environment for all participants both human and equine. Through biosecurity proven good practices such as proof of vaccination for entry, our Only Healthy Horses Policy, an Equine Health Attestation and Agreement, regular stall disinfection, manure removal, the ability to isolate sick horses, access to veterinary care and hospitalization; Wesley Clover Parks has a venue specific plan in place in the event of illness. The following are our requirements in addition to the EC rule for vaccines already in place.

- **PROOF OF VACCINES:** Please upload an invoice or a letter from your veterinarian indicating the horse's show name and date of administration of EHV 1 & 4 and Equine Influenza (as per Article A519). This can be uploaded to your MyESM account through the profile. Competitors failing to meet this requirement will be asked to leave the showgrounds or not permitted entry. Please complete the following forms, available at [ottawaequestriantournaments.com](http://ottawaequestriantournaments.com), prior to arriving on site.
- **COGGINS TEST:** Required for all horses on-site and must be available upon request at show management's discretion
- **EQUINE HEALTH ATTESTATION:** As part of our Healthy Horses Only Policy, each owner or trainer is required to complete an online Equine Health Attestation Form prior to arrival on site. This will indicate that competing horses to the best of the owner/trainer's knowledge have not been in contact with any other horses (away or at their home facility) exhibiting symptoms or signs of respiratory illness within the last 14 days. They also agree to monitor their horse's temperature upon arrival and twice daily while on site. Further, they agree to share knowledge of any sick or horse displaying symptoms of illness to show management immediately at [entries@ wesleycloverparks.com](mailto:entries@wesleycloverparks.com).

**NON COMPETING HORSES:** Each horse on the property must be declared. Horses found on the property without an entry form will be charged an additional fine of \$100.

### WORKING TOGETHER TO MITIGATE THE RISK OF INFECTIOUS DISEASE SPREAD ON SITE:

- Review and ensure you are prepared for quick implementation of an isolation plan at our competition grounds and/or at your home farm or facility.
- Isolate horses at first signs or symptoms of respiratory illness and contact your vet immediately.
- Any horses with a fever over 39 C should isolate in separate facilities on the competition grounds or at separate veterinary facility off-site.
- Keep separate feed buckets, brushes, rags, and tack/equipment for each horse.
- Ask your veterinarian about appropriate sanitizing solutions.
- Eliminate communal or shared water troughs and buckets.
- Practice hand washing in between handling horses.
- Maintain social distancing for horses; no nose to nose contact with other horses.



## COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

Everyone planning to attend the competition must complete ALL of the forms listed on [ottawaequestriantournaments.com](http://ottawaequestriantournaments.com) prior to arrival. Entries in each division will be limited if necessary to ensure provincial guidelines can be followed.

### HOW THE HUNTER RING WILL RUN:

- Classes will run in posted order in groups of 4 horses. Groups will be organized by trainer.
- There will be no jogs. Judge will check for soundness in final circle. Trot for at least half of the circle.
- There will be no under saddle classes.
- Movement awards will be given to the top three in each division. Horses will be judged on this when entering the ring for their first over fences trip. Upon entering the ring, competitors will be judged on walk, trot and canter while heading to the first fence. Movement awards do not count towards division points.
- There will be 3 over fences classes per division. All trips will run concurrently within your group of 4 horses to provide a “show and go” experience.
- Open scoring will be announced for the third over fences class of each division.
- Braiding will not be allowed. Judge will penalize any horse who is braided.

### HOW THE JUMPER RING WILL RUN:

- Classes will run in posted order of go organized by trainer.
- Course walks for the day will be scheduled, while in the ring everyone must maintain physical distancing.

**IMPORTANT: No spectators allowed. Property open to riders, one parent of junior riders, trainers and essential horse care personnel only.**

## RULES & REGULATIONS

Equestrian Canada (EC), the national equestrian federation of Canada, supports adherence to the humane treatment of horses in all activities under its jurisdiction.

Per Article A801, every entry at an EC-sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person responsible that the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver or rider and horse shall be subject to the EC Constitution and all rules of EC and any additional rules set by the competition. It is the responsibility of all individuals participating in any capacity in EC-sanctioned competitions to be knowledgeable regarding the EC Constitution and the applicable rules of EC and the additional rules, if any, imposed by the competition.

Do not participate in this EC-sanctioned competition in any capacity if you do not consent to be bound by the constitution and rules of EC and any additional rules imposed by the competition. (A602.7)



## RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All horses entered in any class at a competition must have met the requirements of Article A519, Vaccinations. See Rules of Equestrian Canada, Section A, General Regulations, Article A519, Vaccinations. **All horses will require current proof of vaccinations uploaded to your MyESM horse profile.**
2. **Rider Falls:** Remounting not allowed. Rider must be checked by Paramedic before they can return to competition. **Horse Falls:** Horse must be cleared by a veterinarian before they return to competition. Any fees incurred are the sole responsibility of the competitor. (G. FEI 224.3 Falls)
3. **Program Changes:** Every class offered herein is covered by the Rules and Specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book (A602.2). Stratford-Fox Run reserves the right to make changes to classes, change the order of classes, to cancel, reschedule, or combine any division they may deem advisable.
4. Competitors on the EC Not In Good Standing List or the EC Medical Suspension list (Article 101 Section A, General Regulations) will be refused entries to the show.
5. **Helmets:** Anyone mounted on a horse on the competition grounds, including foreign competitors, must wear approved helmets, with safety harness correctly fastened, at all times.
6. **Abuse:** Abuse of the horse is strictly forbidden. Excessive use of the whip – a horse should never be hit more than three times for any one incident. EC rule.
7. **NSF cheques:** will be assessed a \$50 surcharge. All cheques payable to Wesley Clover Parks.
8. **Post entries:** Add \$30, no exceptions. All entries received by the secretary following the closing date will be deemed a post entry. If you substitute one horse for another there will be no additional cost.
9. **Prize money:** All prize monies will be mailed by cheque within 21 days of the last day of the competition.
10. **Numbers:** Competition numbers must be worn and be visible at all times during the competition.
11. **Coaches/ Trainers/Persons Responsible:** All trainers/coaches must carry the memberships and sport license equivalent to the level of competition where they are training/coaching.
12. A horse/pony is limited to one round per class including equitation and medal classes.
13. **Draw Reins:** Draw reins are not permissible in Hunter and Jumper Classes. (A602.5)
14. All accounts must be paid in full by end of day Sunday.
15. Refreshments will be provided by Scott's Catering.
16. **Dogs:** It is strongly recommended that dogs be left at home if possible. If not possible dogs must be left in the stabling area and be on a leash at all times. The owners of any dog that is caught will be subject to a \$100 fine. Owners of loose dogs that disrupt a rider on course will be charged for the entry fee of that class, in addition to the \$100 fine. Owners are required to abide by the "Poop and Scoop" by-law.



## OVPSC DIVISION SPECS

- **No under saddle classes.**
- **INTRO HUNTER:** Maximum jump height of 18". Open to beginner riders only in their first or second year of showing, no age limit. Riders may cross enter into Open Hunter 2'0", Pre-Novice/School Horse 2'0", or Training Hunter 2'0" as long as they meet division qualifications. To be judged as a hunter division.
- **PRE-NOVICE/SCHOOL HORSE:** Maximum jump height of 2'0". Intended for riders in their first year of showing (with the exception of the short stirrup, intro or beginner divisions) or riders enrolled in a weekly lesson program riding horses or ponies, owned by, or leased to a riding school, and used regularly in a riding school lesson program. Not open to professionals or riders competing in any division over 2'3" on any circuit. Distances will not be adjusted. Horses and ponies permitted to trot their lead changes. To be judged as a hunter division. Riders may cross enter into Open Hunter 2'0", Intro Hunter 2'0" or Training Hunter 2'0" as long as they meet division qualifications. If not competing in Intro Hunter, these riders may cross enter into Child/Adult Hunter 2'3". Please note: A school horse is a horse or pony ridden by different riders on a regular basis in an ongoing lesson program. If horse/pony is full-leased to a rider it is not considered a school horse.
- **OPEN HUNTER:** Maximum jump height of 2'0". Open to all riders, horses and ponies. Distances will not be adjusted for ponies. No oxers.
- **BRONZE CHILD/ADULT HUNTER:** Maximum jump height of 2'3". Open to junior and amateur riders. Ponies allowed, distances will not be adjusted for ponies. Competitors may cross-enter into other divisions for which they are eligible.
- **BRONZE JUMPER 0.70M:** Consists of three Table A 0.70M classes with a jump off.
- **BRONZE JUMPER 0.80M:** Consists of three Table A 0.80M classes with a jump off. The second class of this division may be a Table A Speed if entries warrant.
- **BRONZE JUMPER 1.20M:** Consists of three classes; two Table A 1.15M classes with jump off, and one Table A 1.20M class with a jump off. The second class of this division may be a Table A Speed if entries warrant.
- **BRONZE JUMPER EQUITATION:** Jump height 0.70M. This class will follow the Bronze Jumper 0.70M classes where offered. Not open to professional riders.
- **Bronze shows may add specialty classes at their discretion.**
- **TRAINING HUNTER:** Non-core, non-pointed division. Open to all riders, horses and ponies

## THJA DIVISION SPECS

All traditional classes/divisions specs are subject to change/update depending on the current state of the COVID 19 pandemic in the province of Ontario. All zones may not be able to offer all classes and divisions because of regional restrictions.



## EQUESTRIAN CANADA STATEMENT OF PRINCIPLE

The Stratford at The Parks hunter jumper competition is pending EC approval as Bronze and Silver competition members of Equestrian Canada, 201–11 Hines Road, Ottawa, ON K2K 2X1, and are governed by the rules of EC. (A602.1) Any horse entered in any class at a competition may be selected for equine medication control testing while at the event location. (A602.5)

### ALL PERSONS SHALL BE COMMITTED TO:

- Upholding the welfare of all horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities.
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment.
- Ensuring that all Equestrians including owners, trainers and competitors, or their respective agents, use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their own horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose.
- Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure.
- Providing current information on Code of Practice for the Care and Handling of Equines and other equine health and welfare initiatives.
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare.
- Requiring owners, trainers and competitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions
- Actively promoting the development and adherence of competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of the horse.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a person who is informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and competition procedures would determine to be neither cruel, abusive, nor inhumane.

**NOTE:** In case of a fall of an athlete and/or a horse at any time in the Competition arena, in the practice arena or elsewhere within the grounds of the Event, the Athlete and or Horse must be cleared by the Event's medical service, respectively the Veterinary Delegate, before the Athlete and/or the Horse may be permitted to take part in the next round or Competition at the Event. (Horses – shoulder and haunch touch the ground, or ground and obstacle). In regards to riders running/walking and falling, or off of golf carts, etc.

## EC ACCIDENTS & RETURN TO PLAY RULE

Equestrian Canada's concussion related Accidents & Return-to-Play Rule came into effect Jan. 1/2017 for all EC sanctioned competitions in Canada. The full rule can be found in the EC Rules, Section A, General Regulations, Article 101. Key components of the rule include the following:

- In the event of a fall/accident where a concussion can be reasonably suspected, the competitors must receive medical clearance by qualified medical personnel on-site before continuing to compete.

- The competitor is solely responsible for ensuring the on-site medical assessment takes place. Should a competitor refuse to be evaluated, they will be disqualified from the competition.
- If on-site qualified medical personnel suspect a concussion or believe the competitor may be at risk of concussion due to the nature of the fall or impact, the competitor will be suspended from competition and placed on a Medical Suspension List until medically released.
- Competitors will remain on the EC Medical Suspension List until they submit an EC Return-to-Play Form, signed by a licensed physician, to EC.
- No competitor shall compete at EC sanctioned competitions while on the EC Medical Suspension List and competition organizers may refuse entry to anyone currently on the list.
